Concerns/Issues from POA: Bonnie Huetter, liaison for POA. POA will send an e-mail to residents about the need for one part-time board member for the water board. POA newsletter has published new water rates in winter/spring edition of Timber Lakes Times. Lot 1281 that is owned by the POA has an offer to purchase. Timber Lakes Water should get paid approximately \$4,500 in back water fees if lot is sold.

Public Comments: Gordon and Bonnie Huetter, lot owners, purchased Lot 409, would like to split the lot and combine with their current lot. Greg Ferrari is drawing up the paperwork. Will have Jared Moss review.

<u>Approval of January 2019 minutes:</u> A motion was made by Steve Farrell to approve the January minutes as written, after correcting heading of Approval of August Warrants to Approval of December Warrants. It was seconded by Reg Anderson and passed unanimously.

<u>Approval of February 2019 warrants</u>: After review and discussion, a motion was made by Michael Wheelwright to approve the warrant list January 16 to February 19, numbers 13640 to 13672, including the credit card payment for February. The motion was seconded by John Blickenstaff and passed unanimously.
